Not far from Lake Carezza, in the Eggental valley, surrounded by lush larch forests and rugged peaks, lies House Carezza. The two new wooden houses translate the alpine architectural tradition of farmhouses into the present by combining materials such as wood and stone with modern technologies and reinterpreting the material separation between the upper and lower parts that is characteristic of this type of building. From above, one can see the asymmetrical roof geometry, which is reminiscent of the rough, fragmented materiality of rocks. Inside, the three floors are staggered so that the view of the panorama is guaranteed at all times. On the ground floor, each flat consists of an entrance area, the kitchen, the living room, and a wardrobe. On the upper floor, the large panoramic windows look directly onto the Dolomites. The building is certified with KlimaHouse A Nature.
